MATERIALS

Five formalin fixed paraffin embedded cell lines with a dynamic range (DR) of expression for a variety of biomarkers.

Cell line B: Breast ductal carcinoma

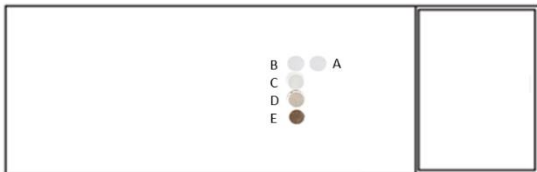

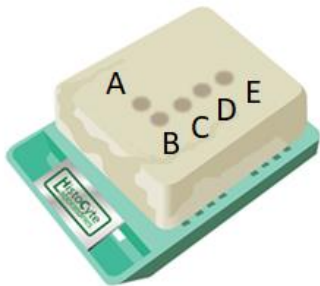

Cells are fixed in 10% neutral buffered formalin and paraffin wax embedded.

Sections are cut at 4µm, mounted on positively charged slides and baked overnight at 37°C.



Cell microarrays (CMA) contain cores that are 2mm in diameter and 3-3.5mm in length. It is possible to obtain over 300 sections depending on thickness.
